JC reported to the Committee that Glenn Paster and he attended and reviewed the project at the last Board of Selectman meeting. The reaction from the Board of Selectman was positive.

Fields at Stanley

MVG presented the proposed field layout for the Stanley site, including a full size soccer field; two little league fields; and 66 parking spaces. MVG is also reviewing if they can add a walking track around the little league fields. Storage and bathroom facilities are not included in the plan.

The Committee requested that the field shown as a "Soccer Field" get referred to as a "Soccer, Field Hockey and Lacrosse Field". The Committee would also like to see one of the little league fields be turned into a playground/park for multiple use. The final grade and materials are still to be determined.

Facilities Assessment Subcommittee (FAS) Meeting

CP shared with the Committee a call on Monday afternoon from the MSBA regarding the PSR submission and FAS meeting. The MSBA noted in the call that comments to the PSR submission are due to be sent out within the next couple of days, and



contingent of the response to the comments and the FAS meeting will be the recommendation to move the project to the November MSBA's Board of Directors meeting.
